

Heritage and Savoir-faire

Beauville - Engayrac : 5.5km



Beauville

Mounting guard at the end of the plateau, the village proudly overlooks the Séoune valley. This characterful village is grouped around the square with its arches and stone or half-timbered houses. At the entrance to the village you will find a very large square planted with horse-chestnut trees. Do not miss the chateau, dating from 13th & 14th centuries at the extreme west end of the village. Back in the central square you will find St James' church, dating from 14th and 16th centuries, with a superb Renaissance door as well as a bell-porch. Free entry.

Apples, Armagnac - and a delicious filo-type pastry base gently pulled out by hand, lightly dried, oiled and sugared.
